

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF WILMERDING, RELATIVE TO THE PROPER CARE, UPKEEP, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE EASTERLY ONE-HALF OF PATTON STREET, ALSO KNOWN AS WILMERDING-MONROEVILLE ROAD, WHICH LIES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, BETWEEN SHAW AVENUE AND MAPLE ALLEY.

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville does hereby ordain and enact the following ordinance.

SECTION 1. The Borough of Monroeville does hereby consent and agree to enter into a contract and agreement with the Borough of Wilmerding, to be executed by the Burgess and the President of Council of each of the respective Boroughs, which contract and agreement by its terms and provisions, shall provide for the proper care, upkeep and maintenance, by the Borough of Wilmerding, of the easterly one-half of Patton Street, also known as Wilmerding-Monroeville Road, as more fully described hereafter, and which is to be vacated by the County of Allegheny to the Borough of Monroeville in proceedings in the Quarter Sessions Courts of Allegheny at No. 1 June Sessions, 1952. (Commissioners Road Docket)

SECTION 2. This agreement between the two Boroughs is to be to the same effect and purpose and is to stand as a substitute, in place and stead of, the former agreement entered into between the Borough of Wilmerding and the County of Allegheny, which was executed in compliance with the Wilmerding Borough Ordinance No. 287 adopted August 18, 1916 relative to the care, upkeep and maintenance of the same portion of said Patton Street, also known as Wilmerding-Monroeville Road.

SECTION 3. That the said agreement between the Borough of Wilmerding and the County of Allegheny, dated August 18, 1916, and the effect thereof, being deemed abrogated by the vacating of control of said portion of Patton Street, also known as Wilmerding-Monroeville Road, by the County of Allegheny to the Borough of Monroeville, it is the intent and purpose of the Borough of Wilmerding to reinstate and continue as heretofore, its obligation, responsibility and liability to the Borough of Monroeville, for the proper care, upkeep and maintenance

hereafter, indefinitely, of the easterly one-half of said Patton Street, also known as Wilmerding-Monroeville Road, as hereinafter described.

SECTION 4. That the portion of Patton Street, also known as Wilmerding-Monroeville Road, which is to be vacated as aforesaid, by the County of Allegheny and transferred to the Borough of Monroeville in the proceedings aforesaid, and over which the Borough of Wilmerding is to be obligated, responsible and liable for the care, upkeep and maintenance of, is shown on the Allegheny County Public Works Ordinance Plan No. 2132B and is bounded and described as follows,

Beginning at the point of intersection of the northerly side line of Shaw Avenue and the easterly side line of Wilmerding and Monroeville Road also known as Patton Street, said point being on the dividing line between Wilmerding and Monroeville Boroughs; thence by said dividing line between Wilmerding and Monroeville Boroughs, said line being the northerly side line of Shaw Avenue extended, North $74^{\circ} 47'$ West for a distance of 18.45 feet to a point on the center line of said Wilmerding and Monroeville Road also known as Patton Street; thence continuing along the dividing line between Wilmerding and Monroeville Boroughs and on the center line of said Wilmerding and Monroeville Road also known as Patton Street, North $6^{\circ} 45'$ East for a distance of 613.42 feet to a point on the extension of the northerly side line of Maple Alley; thence by said extension of the northerly side line of Maple Alley, South $71^{\circ} 16'$ East for a distance of 18.66 feet to a point on the easterly side line of Wilmerding and Monroeville Road also known as Patton Street; thence by said easterly side line of Wilmerding and Monroeville Road also known as Patton Street, South $6^{\circ} 45'$ West for a distance of 612.27 feet to a point on the northerly side line of Shaw Avenue, at the place of beginning. Containing an area of 11,184 square feet.

Being the easterly half of Wilmerding and Monroeville Road also known as Patton Street, as established by the Court of Quarter Sessions of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania at No. 11 March Sessions 1910; from the northerly side line of Shaw Avenue to the northerly side line of Maple Alley, in Monroeville Borough.

SECTION 5. Any ordinance heretofore enacted by the said Borough which is conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same is in conflict herewith.
