

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1952.

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville hereby enacts the following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied upon all property and occupations within the said Borough of Monroeville subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year of 1952, as follows:

- (a) The tax rate for general Borough purposes shall be seven (7) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.
- (b) The tax rate for debt purposes shall be two (2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.
- (c) That the tax rate for fire protection purposes, as effects the districts benefited, shall be two (2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Making a total tax rate for Borough purposes, of nine (9) mills, plus two (2) mills, additional for fire protection in the respective districts of the Borough, benefited.

SECTION 2. The assessed valuation of property in the Borough, used as a basis for taxation purposes, shall be that valuation fixed by the Board of Tax Assessment and Revision of Allegheny County.

SECTION 3. That any ordinance or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
