

ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF COUNCILMEN OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville hereby enacts the following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. That the Councilmen of the Borough of Monroeville shall be paid compensation for their services as Councilmen, commencing as of January, 1952, and that the rate of compensation shall be and the same is fixed at Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars per month, payable quarterly, in March, June, September and December of each year.

SECTION 2. No compensation shall be paid in any month to a Councilman who has failed to attend at least one regular or special meeting of Council during the month, unless specially excused or permission for such absence is granted by Council.

SECTION 3. That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed so far as the same effects this ordinance.
