

ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REGULATING AND PRESCRIBING A "NO PASSING ZONE" ON THE MONROEVILLE ROAD, FROM THE BOROUGH LINE, BETWEEN MONROEVILLE BOROUGH AND TURTLE CREEK BOROUGH, TO KENTUCKY AVENUE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE SAME.

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville, does hereby ordain and enact the following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. That for the promotion and preservation of peace and safety in the Borough, there is hereby created a "no passing zone" upon and along the Easterly half of Monroeville Road in said Borough, from its intersection with the boundry line between the Borough of Monroeville and the Borough of Turtle Creek, at Lynn Avenue, and extending northwardly to a point of intersection with Kentucky Avenue, in said Borough.

SECTION 2. That from and after the adoption of this Ordinance, it will be unlawful for any vehicle, using or traveling upon said portion of said Monroeville Road, to pass another vehicle, using or traveling upon the same, while traveling in the same direction.

SECTION 3. There shall be erected by the proper officers of the Borough, appropriate signs of proper size and markings, designating the beginning and the end of said "no passing zone" upon said Road.

SECTION 4. Any person or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, in summary proceedings before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace of the said Borough; be subject to pay a fine of Ten (\$10.00), together with costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of said fine and costs, shall be committed to the Allegheny County Jail for a period of not more than thirty (30) days.
