

## ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1955.

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville hereby enacts the following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied upon all property and occupations of citizens within the Borough of Monroeville, subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year of 1955 as follows:

(a) The tax rate for general Borough purposes shall be eight (8) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

(b) The tax rate for debt purposes shall be one (1) mill on each dollar of assessed valuation.

(c) That the tax rate for fire protection purposes, as affects the districts benefited shall be two (2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Making a total tax rate of nine (9) mills for Borough purposes and two (2) mills, additional for fire protection, in the respective districts of the Borough, benefited.

SECTION 2. The assessed valuation of property in the Borough and the occupational assessment for citizens of the Borough, used as a basis for taxation purposes, shall be that valuation fixed by the Board of Tax Assessment and Revision of Allegheny County.

SECTION 3. That any ordinance or part of ordinance, conflicting with this Ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
