

ORDINANCE NO. 44

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING, UNDER RIGHTS OF EMINENT DOMAIN, THE CONDEMNATION OF THE SEVERAL STRIPS OF PRIVATELY OWNED LAND WITHIN THE BOROUGH, PROPOSED AND INTENDED TO BE USED AS EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND LAYING OF SANITARY SEWER LINES AS SHOWN ON THE BOROUGH ENGINEER'S PLAN OF AREA A OF THE SANITARY SEWERAGE SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR A BOND; AUTHORIZING THE COMMENCEMENT OF LEGAL ACTION.

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville does hereby ordain and enact the following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. The Borough of Monroeville does hereby exercise its right of eminent domain and by authority thereof does hereby condemn, appropriate and take the several respective strips of privately owned property within the Borough which are proposed and intended to be used as easements and rights-of-way and through, under and along which will be constructed and laid the proposed sanitary sewer line as laid out and shown upon the Borough Engineer's drawing and Plan of Section A of the Sanitary Sewerage System.

SECTION 2. The Borough does hereby authorize and direct the preparation and execution of its own Bond in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, to be submitted or filed in any legal proceedings instituted for the purpose of assessing damages and benefits by either the Borough or any resident interested, involved or aggrieved by acts or actions taken or instituted by virtue hereof.

SECTION 3. The Borough Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to prepare such Bond and to institute and/or defend any action or actions commenced or filed by virtue hereof. The Borough Solicitor is further authorized and directed to prepare and obtain execution for Deeds of easements and rights-of-way for the respective strips of privately owned property to be used as easements and rights-of-way for the construction and laying of the sanitary sewer lines contemplated and proposed under general plan of the Borough's Sanitary Sewerage System.
