

ORDINANCE NO. 67

PROVIDING FOR AND ESTABLISHING THE FEES TO BE PAID FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF CONNECTING TO THE SANITARY SEWERS OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE IN AREA "A" SECTIONS 6, 7 and 8.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that on and after the date of the final adoption of this Ordinance, no person, individual, corporation or partnership shall connect any building, dwelling, or other structure or improvement with the sanitary sewers of the Borough of Monroeville located in Area "A", Sections 6, 7 and 8, without first having filed a written request for the authority to do so with the Borough Secretary and having paid at the time of filing of such request the fee established for the privilege of making such connection.

SECTION 2. The areas covered by this Ordinance are those appearing upon an Official Borough Plan prepared by the Thompson Survey Service, numbered E455 & E455A and dated August 19, 1955 and September 2, 1955. A copy of said Plan shall be maintained in the Office of the Borough Secretary subject to examination by the Public.

SECTION 3. The fee to be paid for each connection to be made to the sanitary sewers of the Borough of Monroeville located in Area "A", Sections 6, 7 and 8 shall be and is hereby fixed at Three Hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$350.00) Dollars. In determining what shall be a single or multiple connection, the following regulations shall apply.

(a) For a dwelling house, each family unit shall be a separate connection so that, a duplex or double house shall be two connections, a triplex shall be three connections and an apartment house shall be the number of connections that there are family units in said building:

(b) In the case of a hotel, motel, or other similar arrangement, where the unit of occupancy is normally only one room and adjacent toilet facilities, each such room shall be considered a separate connection, but in that instance the fee for each connection shall be Two Hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$250.00) Dollars;

(c) In the case of connections to locations where commercial business is carried on, each separate business location shall be considered to be a separate connection and the grouping of two or more such locations under one ownership, management or leasehold shall not in any way reduce the number of connections;

(d) It shall have no effect upon the number of connections, that several locations, business or otherwise, are coupled on to a sanitary interceptor which, in turn, is connected to the sewers of the Borough of Monroeville in Area "A", Sections 6, 7 and 8.

SECTION 4. The owners of the land upon which the buildings, dwellings or other structures or improvements are located are the ones primarily responsible for the payment of the connection fees established herein, but the failure of said owners to pay said connection fees shall in no way permit the use of the Borough sewers by persons who stand in the relationship of tenants, squatters, mortgagees or otherwise.

SECTION 5. It shall be a violation of this Ordinance and punishable by a fine of One Hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) Dollars to be recovered by the Borough of Monroeville before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace of said Borough, for any person, individual, corporation or partnership to make a connection to the sanitary sewers of the Borough of Monroeville, located in Area "A", Sections 6, 7 and 8, without having first made the written request and paid the fee specified in this Ordinance for such privilege. Each day that such unlawful connection exists shall be a separate violation. Upon the failure to pay such fines after conviction shall cause the violator to be imprisoned in the Allegheny County Jail for a period of thirty (30) days for each separate offense.

SECTION 6. That any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
