

ORDINANCE NO. 69

PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION BY THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE OF THE STORM SEWER AND EASEMENT OWNED BY GEORGE GOJKOVICH AND LOCATED IN GOJKOVICH PLANS NUMBERED ONE AND TWO IN SAID BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, GEORGE GOJKOVICH, SR. is the owner of a storm sewer consisting of two (2) separate pipes extending from Logans Ferry Road, through Lots 110, 111, 112, 113, 129, 130, 131 and 132 in the George Gojkovich Plan No. 1, Plan Book Vol. 50, pages 5 - 6, and Lots 1 and 133 in George Gojkovich Plan No. 2, Plan Book Vol. 52, page 81, which said pipes are laid in an easement ten (10) feet wide; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Monroeville, being desirous of acquiring said storm sewer and easement has agreed with George Gojkovich, Sr. to purchase the same from him for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00)

NOW, THEREFORE: -

SECTION 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that the Borough of Monroeville purchase the storm sewer and ten (10) foot easement in which the same is constructed from Logans Ferry Road, through Lots 110, 111, 112, 113, 129, 130, 131 and 132 of George Gojkovich Plan No. 1, Plan Book Vol. 50, pages 5 - 6, and Lots 1 and 133 in George Gojkovich Plan No. 2, Plan Book Vol. 52, page 81, to the point beyond River Vue Drive where the same empties into a natural water course, from George Gojkovich, Sr. for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and the proper officers are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Borough of Monroeville, all of the papers necessary to said purchase.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
