

ORDINANCE NO. 72

PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE UPON THE ROADS AND STREETS OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE WHEN THE WHEELS OF SAID VEHICLE OR THE TRACTION THEREOF IS EQUIPPED WITH CLEATS, BLOCKS, STUDS, FLANGES OR ANY OTHER PROTUBERANCE; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and the Council of the Borough of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that:

SECTION 1: From and after the effective date of this ordinance, no person or corporation shall operate any motor vehicle upon the roads and streets of the Borough of Monroeville, which said vehicle shall have attached to the periphery of its wheels or to the traction of said motor vehicle any cleat, block, stud, flange or other protuberance, without having secured a permit to so operate.

SECTION 2: A permit to operate a motor vehicle, the wheels of which or the traction of which shall be equipped with cleats, blocks, studs, flanges or other protuberance, shall be granted by the Borough Secretary only after the application for such permit shall have been referred to and approved by the Chief of Police of the Borough. The fee for said permit shall be the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and the person or corporation to whom the permit shall be granted shall agree, in writing, to restore fully, the surface of any road or street that shall be affected thereby.

SECTION 3: The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to purely farm machinery travelling on a road or street in Monroeville between two points on the farm owned by the owner of the vehicle.

SECTION 4: Any person or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before the Burgess or a Justice of the Peace, for a first offense, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution and in default of payment, undergo imprisonment for a period of ten (10) days; for a second offense, to be sentenced to pay a fine of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and the costs of prosecution and in default of

payment thereof, undergo imprisonment for a period of twenty (20) days and for a third and subsequent offense, to be sentenced to pay a fine of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and the costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof, undergo imprisonment for a period of thirty (30) days. Each separate calendar day shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5: Any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with the terms of this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
