

ORDINANCE NO. 85

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE TAX COLLECTOR FOR THE YEAR 1957.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

SECTION ONE: The compensation of the Tax Collector of the Borough of Monroeville for the collection by him of the taxes set forth on the duplicates for the year 1957 is hereby fixed at two and one-half percentum ($2\frac{1}{2}\%$) for all taxes collected at discount and at face. For all taxes collected at a penalty due to delinquency, the collector shall receive five percentum (5%).

SECTION TWO: All expenses of the operation of the Tax Collector's Office, other than those specifically directed by the law to be paid by the Borough, shall be paid by the Tax Collector.

SECTION THREE: Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance that shall conflict with this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
