

ORDINANCE NO. 94

PROHIBITING THE OPERATING OF MOTOR VEHICLES OVER AND ACROSS THE CURBS IN THE STREETS AND ROADS OF MONROEVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and the Council of the Borough of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE: On and after the effective date of this Ordinance, no person shall operate a motor vehicle, either forward or backward over or across the curbs of the streets of Monroeville.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall not be effective where

- (a) Curbs have been designed, but not yet installed.
- (b) There is an emergency and the crossing of the curbs has been authorized by a police officer.
- (c) The curbs that have been installed have been cut in accordance with permission granted by the Borough Council.

SECTION THREE: For each violation of the terms of this Ordinance, the person so violating shall be fined the sum of Five and no/100 (\$5.00) and the costs of prosecution, or the alternative of Five (5) days in the County Jail in a proceeding before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace of the Borough of Monroeville.

SECTION FOUR: Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
