

## ORDINANCE NO. 98

PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN HARRY W. CORBETT COMPANY, A PENNSYLVANIA CORPORATION AND THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A MUNICIPAL BUILDING FOR THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and the Council of the Borough of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION ONE: WHEREAS, the Borough Council has resolved to construct a municipal building for the Borough of Monroeville, and in order to do so have had plans and specifications prepared by the architectural firm of HURA AND CRAVOTTA; and,

SECTION TWO: WHEREAS, the said Borough, in accordance with said plans and specifications did advertise for bids for the general construction of said building, as well as the installation of the plumbing, the heating, and the electrical work; and,

SECTION THREE: WHEREAS, the HARRY W. CORBETT COMPANY, a Pennsylvania corporation, having its principal place of business at 1750 North Highland Road, Bethel Borough, Pennsylvania, was the lowest responsible bidder for the general construction contract in the total sum of One Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Nine Hundred and no/100 (\$143,900.00) Dollars; and,

SECTION FOUR: The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with the HARRY W. CORBETT COMPANY for the general construction of a municipal building for the Borough of Monroeville in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by HURA AND CRAVOTTA for the sum of One Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Nine Hundred and no/100 (\$143,900.00) Dollars; and,

SECTION FIVE: Contemporaneously with the execution of the contract, the HARRY W. CORBETT COMPANY shall post with the Borough Secretary a performance bond in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the contract, a labor and materialmen's bond and shall file with the Secretary of the Borough a certificate of insurance

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showing Workmen's Compensation Insurance as required by law and public liability insurance to the extent of \$100,000.00- \$300,000.00 personal injury, and \$25,000.00- \$50,000.00 property damage.

SECTION SIX: That any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
