

ORDINANCE NO. 99

PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN IRWIN ROSENBERG AND OTTO KUTTLER doing business as GARFIELD REFRIGERATION COMPANY AND THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE FOR THE HEATING AND VENTILATING OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING FOR THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same;

SECTION ONE: Whereas, the Borough Council has resolved to construct a municipal building for the Borough of Monroeville, and in order to do so have had plans and specifications prepared by the architectural firm of HURA and CRAVOTTA; and,

SECTION TWO: Whereas, the said Borough, in accordance with said plans and specifications did advertise for bids for the general construction of said building, as well as for the installation of the plumbing, the heating and ventilating and the electrical work; and,

SECTION THREE: Whereas IRWIN ROSENBERG and OTTO KUTTLER, doing business as GARFIELD REFRIGERATION COMPANY, having its principal place of business at 5026 Penn Ave., Pittsburgh, Pa., was the lowest responsible bidder for the heating and ventilating contract in the total sum of Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety and no/100 (\$13,890.00) Dollars; and,

SECTION FOUR: The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with IRWIN ROSENBERG and OTTO KUTTLER, doing business as GARFIELD REFRIGERATION COMPANY, for the heating and ventilating in the municipal building to be constructed for the Borough of Monroeville in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by HURA and CRAVOTTA, for the sum of Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety and no/100 (\$13,890.00) Dollars; and,

SECTION FIVE: Contemporaneously with the execution of the contract, IRWIN ROSENBERG and OTTO KUTTLER, doing business as GARFIELD REFRIGERATION COMPANY, shall post with the Borough Secretary a performance bond in the amount of fifty per-

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cent (50%) of the contract, a labor and materialmen's bond and shall file with the Borough Secretary a certificate of insurance showing Workmen's Compensation Insurance, as required by law, and public liability insurance to the extent of \$100,000.00--\$300,000.00 for personal injury and \$25,000.00--\$50,000.00 for property damage.

SECTION SIX: That any Ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.
