

BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 182

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL INCREMENTS TO THE PAY OF POLICEMEN OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE FROM THE FIFTH TO FIFTEENTH YEAR OF SERVICE.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough to properly compensate its loyal police officers; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough of Monroeville to provide a system which would enable it to attract and keep the highest type of personnel on the police force.

THEREFORE, be it enacted, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 1. All those members of the Monroeville Police Force who have served more than five (5) years on the Monroeville Police Force shall receive, during the year 1960, an increment of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars for their fifth year of service and Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars for each year of service thereafter but not to exceed eleven (11) increments.

Section 2. Hereafter, after the completion of four (4) years of service on the Monroeville Police Force, each member of the Police Force who continues on duty shall receive an increment of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars for the fifth (5) year of service and Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars for each year thereafter to continue until the completion of Fifteen (15) years of service and not to exceed eleven (11) increments.

Section 3. Any Ordinances or part of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they shall be in conflict herewith.
