

ORDINANCE NO. 317

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER IN ACCORDANCE WITH PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS PREPARED AND PROVIDED BY PRIDE ENGINEERING ASSOCIATES, INC., KNOWN AS THE CLOVER DRIVE SEWER PROJECT, CONTRACT NO. 6-S, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION THEREOF WITH CONTRACTORS DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, INC., AND PROVIDING FOR THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. That a sanitary sewer line be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville to service certain properties abutting, or in the vicinity of Clover Drive, in accordance with, and as shown on, Contract No. 6-S of the Borough of Monroeville, as prepared by Pride Engineering Associates, Inc.

SECTION 2. That the said sewer line shall be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the said Pride Engineering Associates, Inc., which plans are on file in the office of the Borough Manager, Municipal Building, Monroeville, Pa.

SECTION 3. Upon the opening of bids for the building of the said Clover Drive Sewer Project, Contract No. 6-S, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder for the construction thereof is Contractors Development Company, Inc., a Pennsylvania Corporation, whose gross sum bid is THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED NINETY-ONE (\$34,691.00) DOLLARS.

SECTION 4. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Contractors Development Company, Inc. for the construction of the said Clover Drive Sewer Project, being Contract No. 6-S of the Borough of Monroeville, according to the plans and specifications, conditions and agreements therein contained, as established by Pride Engineering Associates, Inc., for the gross sum of THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED NINETY-ONE (\$34,691.00) DOLLARS, Provided, however, that the said officers of the Borough shall secure a further letter of agreement from the said Contractors Development Company, Inc. that construction of the said project shall not commence prior to April 15, 1962, unless specifically authorized to do so by further action of Monroeville Borough Council.

SECTION 5. Before the said Contract shall be executed, the said Contractors Development Company, Inc. shall have filed with the Borough Secretary a performance bond in the amount of THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED NINETY-ONE (\$34,691.00) DOLLARS, a labor and materialmen's bond in the amount of THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED NINETY-ONE (\$34,691.00) DOLLARS, a maintenance bond in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED THREE DOLLARS AND SIXTY-FIVE CENTS (\$5,203.65) and certificates of insurance covering personal injury,

property damage and workmen's compensation and liability, all as set forth and required under said Contract No. 6-S.

SECTION 6. That the costs, damages and expenses for the construction of the said sewer line shall be collected from the property owners specially benefited thereby in the manner as now prescribed or as may be hereafter prescribed by law.

SECTION 7. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance that shall conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
