

ORDINANCE NO. 320

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY FOR THE MAYOR AND FOR THE COUNCILMEN OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. The salary of the Mayor of the Borough of Monroeville is hereby fixed at FIFTEEN HUNDRED (\$1,500.00) DOLLARS per annum, payable in monthly installments from the general funds of the Borough.

SECTION 2. The salary of each of the Councilmen of the Borough of Monroeville is hereby fixed at ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS per month, payable monthly from the general funds of the Borough, provided however, that no compensation or salary shall be paid in any month to any Councilman who has failed to attend at least one regular meeting of Borough Council for that month.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective as of the first Monday in January, 1962.

SECTION 4. Any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
