

ORDINANCE NO. 321

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 311 IMPOSING A TAX FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES ON THE USE OR OCCUPANCY OF HOUSE TRAILERS OR MOBILE HOMES IN THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE DURING THE YEAR 1962.

Whereas, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania during its Legislative Session of 1961 did amend its Act of June 25, 1947, P.L. 1145 by deleting therefrom any power or authority of municipalities to separately tax the use or occupancy of house trailers or mobile homes; and

Whereas, such amending legislation has become effective for the Borough of Monroeville for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 1962.

Now, Therefore, be it ordained and enacted by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, and it is hereby so ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

Ordinance No. 311 of the Borough of Monroeville, duly enacted November 14, 1961 and entitled as follows:

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A TAX FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES ON THE USE OR OCCUPANCY OF HOUSE TRAILERS OR MOBILE HOMES IN THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DURING THE YEAR 1962 REQUIRING THE FILING OF REPORTS AND RETURNS AND PROVIDING THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE ORDINANCE AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF,

be, and the same is hereby repealed.
