

ORDINANCE NO. 326

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE CREATING A CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION FOR THE POLICE FORCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville in Council assembled, and it is ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created in the Borough of Monroeville a Civil Service Commission for the Police Force of the Borough of Monroeville. The Commission shall consist of THREE (3) COMMISSIONERS, who shall be qualified electors of the Borough, and shall be appointed by the Council of the Borough of Monroeville initially to serve for terms of TWO (2), FOUR (4), and SIX (6) YEARS, commencing from the first Monday in January, 1962; and as Terms thereafter expire, shall be appointed for Terms of SIX (6) YEARS.

SECTION 2. The Civil Service Commission shall have all the powers, duties and responsibilities, and shall follow all of the procedures as set forth under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania pertaining thereto, and as they may be hereafter amended.

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance, or part of Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance, is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
