

ORDINANCE NO. 330

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE FIXING THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, AND PROVIDING FOR HOLIDAYS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. The officers and employees to conduct the affairs and business of the Borough in accordance with the requirements fixed by law, together with their compensation from and after the effective date hereof, shall be as follows:

BOROUGH ENGINEER	--	833.33 per month
SOLICITOR (Retainer)	--	100.00 per month
CHIEF BOOKKEEPER and ASSISTANT SECRETARY	--	500.00 per month
ASSISTANT BOOKKEEPER	--	376.00 per month
CLERK-TYPISTS	--	325.00 per month
FILE CLERK	--	250.00 per month
BUILDING INSPECTOR	--	440.00 per month
ASSISTANT INSPECTOR	--	400.00 per month
DISPOSAL PLANT SUPERVISOR	--	400.00 per month
ROAD SUPERVISOR	--	580.00 per month
JANITOR	--	400.00 per month
DOG CATCHER	--	100.00 per month
DISPOSAL PLANT OPERATORS	--	2.06 per hour
LABORERS	--	2.06 per hour
TRUCK DRIVERS	--	2.16 per hour
SKILLED CARPENTERS	--	2.28 per hour
SKILLED MASONS	--	2.28 per hour
EQUIPMENT OPERATORS	--	2.28 per hour

POLICE:

CHIEF OF POLICE	--	700.00 per month
SERGEANTS	--	480.00 per month
PATROLMEN	--	450.00 per month
PATROLMEN (Probationary Pay)	--	400.00 per month
DESK CLERKS	--	400.00 per month
SCHOOL POLICE	--	1.75 per hour
SPECIAL POLICE	--	1.75 per hour

In addition, all regular members of the Police Force, exclusive of Special Police or School Police, shall be entitled to additional annual increments of pay as provided by Ordinance No. 182 of the Borough of Monroeville.

SECTION 2. No Borough Employees shall be required to report for work or perform any work on the following days:

NEW YEAR'S DAY
MEMORIAL DAY
FOURTH OF JULY
LABOR DAY
THANKSGIVING DAY
CHRISTMAS DAY

In addition, road employees shall be excused from duty on Washington's Birthday, office employees shall be excused from duties on Good Friday, and the Police shall be excused from duty on Easter.

Should any of the foregoing persons be required to work on a day from which they have been excused, that employee shall be compensated at twice the normal amount of pay for a regular day.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective the 4th day of March, 1962.

SECTION 4. Any Ordinance or part of Ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance, is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
