

ORDINANCE NO. 356

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) HIGHWAY TRUCKS OUT OF REVENUE OF THE 1962 BOND ISSUE.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Borough of Monroeville in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

Section 1. That the proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in form approved by the Borough Solicitor for the purchase of two (2) Highway Trucks for the general use of the Borough of Monroeville from King Kirsch Motor Company for a total consideration of \$16,620.00, and to pay for the same out of the proceeds of the 1962 Bond Issue of the Borough of Monroeville. The said trucks shall conform to the specifications as established by the Borough Secretary and submitted by the said King Kirsch Motor Company in its bid duly awarded at a regular meeting of Council on June 27, 1962.

Section 2. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
