

ORDINANCE NO. 382

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ACCEPTING THE BID OF FRED DI NARDO & SONS, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM TO SERVE A TRACT OF LAND IN MONROEVILLE BOROUGH KNOWN AS "MONROEVILLE INDUSTRIAL PARK" AND A TRACT OF LAND ADJOINING THAT SITE AND OWNED BY RUSSELL P. MILLER, INC. BEING CONTRACT NO. 6207-S, FOR A TOTAL SUM OF \$49,786.30, AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER OFFICERS OF THE BOROUGH TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE BOROUGH.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

SECTION 1: The Council of the Borough of Monroeville hereby orders that a sanitary sewer line be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville to service certain properties abutting or in the vicinity of the Monroeville Industrial Park and a tract of land adjoining that site and owned by Russell P. Miller, Inc. in accordance with and as shown on the plans and specifications of the Borough of Monroeville set forth in Contract 6207-S.

SECTION 2: That the said sewer line shall be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications as approved by the Borough Engineer of the Borough of Monroeville which plans are on file in the office of the Borough Manager, Municipal Building, Monroeville, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 3: Upon the opening of the bids for the said sewer project, Contract No. 6207-S, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder for construction thereof was Fred DiNardo & Sons, Inc. whose gross sum bid is \$49,786.30. The bid is hereby accepted and the contract awarded to Fred DiNardo & Sons, Inc.

SECTION 4: The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Fred DiNardo & Sons, Inc. for the construction of the said sewer project Contract 6207-S, according to the plans, specifications, conditions and agreements therein contained as established and approved by the Borough Engineer of the Borough of Monroeville for the gross sum of \$49,786.30.

-- SECTION 5. Upon execution of the said Contract, the said Contractor shall file with the Borough Secretary a performance bond equal to one Hundred (100%) per cent of the gross sum bid, a labor and materialmens bond equal to fifty (50%) per cent of gross sum bid, and certificates of insurance covering personal injury, property damage and workmen's compensation and liability, all as set forth and required under Contract No. 6207-S.

SECTION 6: That the costs, damages and expenses for the construction of said sewer line in a sum not to exceed \$42000

shall be paid by Russell P. Miller, Inc. in accordance with Ordinance No. 338 of Monroeville Borough.

SECTION 7: Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance that shall conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
