

ORDINANCE NO. 398

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 375, BEING THE "ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE" TO AMEND SECTION 1710 ENTITLED "VIOLATION; PENALTY:" SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR SUMMARY CONVICTION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION ONE: That Section 1710 of Ordinance numbered 375 of the Borough of Monroeville is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1710, Violation; Penalty: Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before the mayor, a magistrate or justice of the peace of the Borough of Monroeville, be fined not to exceed one hundred (100) dollars for any one (1) offense recoverable with costs, judgment, or imprisonment, not exceeding thirty (30) days, if the amount of said judgment and costs shall not be paid. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense. Proceedings against violators shall be instituted by the Zoning Officer, upon his own, or upon direction of the Borough Council, the Planning Commission or the Board of Adjustment. It shall be the duty of the Zoning Officer to investigate any complaint filed in writing by a citizen or any public or private agency or corporation touching violations of this ordinance, and to act thereon if the facts so warrant."

SECTION TWO: Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
