

ORDINANCE NO. 494

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER LINE KNOWN AS ROUTE 22 SANITARY SEWER PROJECT, CONTRACT NO. 6501-S, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That a sanitary sewer line be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville to provide sanitary sewer service for an area of the Borough along and in the vicinity of William Penn Highway from Northern Pike westward to the Borough line, in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Route 22 Sanitary Sewer Project, Contract No. 6501-S.

Section 2. That the said sanitary sewer line shall be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications as prepared by the Monroeville Borough Engineer, which plans are on file at the office of the Borough Engineer, Municipal Building, Monroeville, Pennsylvania.

Section 3. Upon the opening of bids for the building of said sewer Project, Contract No. 6501-S, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder for the construction thereof was Nicassio & Sons, Inc., whose gross sum bid was One Hundred Eight Thousand Forty-two and 50/100 (\$108,042.50) Dollars.

Section 4. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Nicassio & Sons, Inc. for the construction of the said Sanitary Sewer Project, Contract No. 6501-S, according to the plans, specifications, conditions and agreements therein contained and established and approved by the Monroeville Borough Engineer, for the gross sum of One Hundred Eight Thousand Forty-two and 50/100 (\$108,042.50) Dollars.

Section 5. Upon the execution of the said contract said contractor shall file with the Monroeville Borough Manager the performance bond, labor and materialmen's bonds, maintenance bond and certificates of insurance, as required under the terms of said contract.

Section 6. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
