

ORDINANCE NO. 516

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE CONSENTING
TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A RECREATION PLACE BY THE BOROUGH
OF PITCAIRN TO BE LOCATED WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS
OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE

WHEREAS the Borough of Pitcairn, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania has requested of the Borough of Monroeville its consent to the establishment by the said Borough of Pitcairn of a certain recreation place within the territorial limits of the Borough of Monroeville; and

WHEREAS prior consent to such establishment is necessary by the Borough of Monroeville pursuant to Section 2702 of the Borough Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as amended; and

WHEREAS it is deemed by the Borough of Monroeville that the proximity of such recreation place to be established by the Borough of Pitcairn shall also inure to the benefit of many of the citizens and residents of the Borough of Monroeville, as well as the citizens and residents of the Borough of Pitcairn; and

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that continued cooperative and harmonious relationships be maintained with adjacent municipalities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Monroeville hereby signifies its consent for the Borough of Pitcairn to acquire private property within the territorial limits of the Borough of Monroeville for use as a municipal recreation place and other purposes, as set forth in Section 2702 of the Borough Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as amended.

Section 2. The area that may be acquired by the Borough of Pitcairn for the purposes set forth above shall be limited to all or any part of that tract of land now or formerly of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company situate on the Southerly side of Broadway (45 feet wide) within the Borough of Monroeville and bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southerly line of Broadway at its intersection with the extension of the Easterly line of Center Avenue (50 feet wide), the said point of beginning further being on the dividing line between the Borough of Pitcairn and the Borough of Monroeville; thence through property of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company the

following courses and distances: South 10° 50' East, one hundred thirty-five (135) feet to a point; thence South 40° 35' East, four hundred (400) feet to a point; thence South 63° 50' East, five hundred (500) feet to a point; thence North 56° 45' East, three hundred sixty (360) feet to a point; thence North 33° 15' West, one hundred eighty-four (184) feet to a point; thence North 47° 50' East, four hundred fifty-two and 74/100 (542.74) feet to a point; thence South 79° 10' West, one hundred eleven and 35/100 (111.35) feet to a point; thence North 10° 50' West, one hundred fourteen (114) feet to a point on the Southerly line of Broadway aforesaid; thence along said Southerly line of Broadway being the dividing line between the Borough of Pitcairn and the Borough of Monroeville, South 79° 10' West, four hundred seventy-six and 65/100 (476.65) feet to the point at the place of beginning.

CONTAINING nine and 625/1000 (9.625) acres.

Section 3. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
