

ORDINANCE NO. 542

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE DIRECTING THE RECONSTRUCTION OF A PORTION OF OLD WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That a portion of Old William Penn Highway be reconstructed and repaved commencing from the westerly Borough line and extending eastwardly a distance of 3400 lineal feet more or less, all in accordance with plans and specifications therefore on file with the Monroeville Borough Engineer, Municipal Building, Monroeville, Pennsylvania.

Section 2. Upon the opening of bids for the reconstruction of the said portion of Old William Penn Highway, it appearing that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Burrell Construction Co., whose gross sum bid was Thirty-one Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-one and 50/100 (\$31,981.50) Dollars, the proper officers of the Borough are therefore authorized and directed to enter into a contract with said low bidder therefor and in said amount.

Section 3. Upon the execution of the said contract said contractor shall file with the Monroeville Borough Manager all bonds and certificates of insurance required thereunder.
