

ORDINANCE NO. 543

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING THE WAGES AND SALARIES ORDINANCE NO. 479.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Article II of Ordinance No. 479, the Wages and Salaries Ordinance of the Borough of Monroeville, is hereby further amended by adding the following additional employee classifications under the heading of "Clerical, Fiscal and Administrative" and providing for the monthly compensation therefor:

Section 2. Section 1 of Article II of said Ordinance No. 479 is further amended by adding additional pay steps to certain employee classifications, as follows:

Section 3. Any Ordinance or part of Ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Councilman Baum was absent. The President of Borough Council announced that the vote was 5 to 1 in favor of upholding the Mayor's veto and the Ordinance is therefore deemed to be null and void and of no effect.

Dear Mr. Witt:


I am in receipt of Borough Ordinance No. 543 approved at your regular Council meeting held August 9, 1968.
