

## ORDINANCE NO. 558

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF KELVINGTON DRIVE, BRADBERRY DRIVE, CHATHAM LANE AND CASTLEHILL ROAD.

WHEREAS a certain plan of streets and lots has heretofore been laid out and approved by the Borough of Monroeville, known as Kelvington Estates Plan No. 1 and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania in Plan Book Vol. 79, Page 159, and all streets shown on said Plan have been paved and storm water and sanitary sewers have been installed within such streets or easements provided therefor pursuant to standards acceptable to the Borough of Monroeville; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Monroeville has been requested to accept the said streets, together with the accompanying storm water and sanitary sewer systems as shown on the "As Built" plan therefor submitted to and approved by the Monroeville Borough Engineer, to be part of the municipal street, storm water and sanitary sewer systems of the Borough of Monroeville;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Monroeville hereby accepts the dedication of Kelvington Drive, Bradberry Drive, Chatham Lane and Castlehill Road, all fifty (50) feet wide (except where widened at cul de sacs), all as shown and laid out in the Kelvington Estates Plan No. 1 plan of lots, recorded as aforesaid, containing a total length of two thousand one hundred sixty-four (2,164) feet more or less.

Section 2. The Borough of Monroeville hereby accepts for municipal purposes all the storm water and sanitary sewers servicing the lots adjacent to the streets hereinabove described and located within the said street rights-of-way or adjacent lots, together with any easements or additional rights-of-way therefor as shown on said Plan, to be part of the storm water and sanitary sewer systems of the Borough of Monroeville. The grades for the streets accepted hereunder are hereby established as the existing grades, reserving however to the Borough of Monroeville the right to change such grades without liability to adjacent property or property owners therefor.

Section 3. The Council of the Borough of Monroeville by separate resolution shall more precisely locate the said streets and establish

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the existing grade at the center line in accordance with the "As Built" plan of the same submitted to and approved by the Monroeville Borough Engineer.
