

ORDINANCE NO. 569

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER AND DUTIES THEREOF AND ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR SEIZURE AND DETENTION OF ANIMALS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The office of Animal Control Officer is hereby established for the Borough of Monroeville, Such officer shall be deemed a "police officer" as that term is used in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania "Dog Law of 1965", and shall have the powers and duties of a "police officer" in respect to the administration and enforcement of the said Dog Law and prosecutions thereunder.

Section 2. The said Animal Control Officer shall be under the control and jurisdiction of the Chief of Police, and shall be deemed his agent for the purpose of disposition of dogs.

Section 3. The said Animal Control Officer shall have the further duty and responsibility of enforcing any Borough of Monroeville ordinances relating to the control of animals, birds or fowl. Said Animal Control Officer shall not have any other duties, authority or responsibility of a police officer of the Borough of Monroeville.

Section 4. The Mayor shall prescribe a uniform and badge which may be worn by the Animal Control Officer, and the said officer shall be entitled to the same uniform cost allowance as is provided for regular police officers of the Borough of Monroeville.

Section 5. The Borough of Monroeville shall charge the owner of any dog seized in the administration and enforcement of the said Dog Law the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars for such seizure, and the additional sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars per day for expenses incurred by reason of its detention. Such charges shall be paid prior to the releasing of any dog to its owner. Similar charges shall be imposed for any other animal, bird or fowl seized and detained under Borough ordinance or other laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 6. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
