

ORDINANCE NO. 612

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING WAGES AND SALARIES ORDINANCE NO. 479.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Article II of Ordinance No. 479, the Wages and Salaries Ordinance of the Borough of Monroeville, is hereby further amended by adding the following additional employee classifications under the heading of "Labor and Labor Supervision", and providing for the monthly compensation therefor.

| Refuse Collector        | 451           | 474           | 498           | 524           |
| Refuse Collector-Driver | 474           | 498           | 524           | 549           |

Section 2. Section 11 of said Article II shall be amended by adding thereto the following additional sub-section:

(f) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Section or Section 9 of this Article, all employees under the classification of "Refuse Collector" and "Refuse Collector-Driver" shall have their work assignments so arranged by the Borough Manager that their work day shall approximate eight hours and their work week shall approximate forty hours when viewed and averaged over a period of one year. Such employees shall not be entitled to any overtime compensation or commensurate time off unless required to perform work in excess of that previously assigned. Such employees shall, however, be entitled to double time compensation if required to work on paid holidays. Such employees shall be entitled to terminate work each day as soon as assigned work is satisfactorily completed unless assigned additional work on an overtime basis.

Section 3. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
