

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF MacBETH DRIVE TO TILBROOK ROAD, WIDENING AND CHANGING THE GRADE OF A PORTION OF TILBROOK ROAD, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. MacBeth Drive shall be laid out, opened and extended from a point near its existing westerly terminus and extending northwestwardly to connect with Tilbrook Road at a grade and according to the plan and location for the same as shown on MacBeth Drive and Tilbrook Road Contract No. 68 R-1 on file in the office of the Monroeville Borough Engineer, Municipal Building, Monroeville, Pennsylvania. The deeds of dedication of the right of way for said portion of MacBeth Drive, totaling approximately five hundred fifty (550) feet in length, from Stratford Apartments, Inc. and from Margaret L. Arelt and Frederick Arelt, her husband, are hereby accepted and the properties contained therein are hereby designated as part of the municipal street system of the Borough of Monroeville. That portion of property commencing from the westerly terminus of existing MacBeth Drive to the easterly line of Tilbrook Road is further designated as an additional section of MacBeth Drive.

Section 2. The grade elevation of Tilbrook Road for a length of approximately one thousand twenty-five (1,025) feet, as shown and designated on the said Contract No. 68 R-1, is hereby re-established according to the grade elevations shown in the said contract drawings.

Section 3. Upon the opening of competitive bids for the supply of labor, material and equipment for all work to be done under the said Contract No. 68 R-1 relative to the original paving of the additional portion of MacBeth Drive and the widening, regrading and repaving of a portion of Tilbrook Road, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Weiss Bros. Construction, Inc., whose bid based on unit cost estimated in the said contract was Seventy-seven Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty (\$77,880.00) Dollars.

Section 4. The President of Council and Secretary are authorized to enter into a contract with the said Weiss Bros. Construction, Inc. for all of the work embodied in the said Contract No. 68 R-1 and without any bid alternates, for the consideration as set forth above. The said contract shall be in a manner and form to be prepared by or approved by the Monroeville Borough Solicitor.

Section 5. All costs and expenses required for the completion of the work contemplated hereunder shall be paid out of Monroeville Borough Bond Issue Fund Series 1968.

Section 6. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
