

ORDINANCE NO. 625

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE RETAINING OF JOHN F. MAGUIRE, ILLUMINATION CONSULTANT, FOR THE DESIGN OF A STREET LIGHTING SYSTEM AND RELATED FACILITIES FOR A PORTION OF WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY AND HAYMAKER ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That John F. Maguire, Illumination Consultant, shall be retained by the Borough of Monroeville for the design of a street lighting system and attendant facilities (exclusive of electrical circuitry) for the portion of William Penn Highway extending from the westerly borough line eastwardly to the Pennsylvania Turnpike and along Haymaker Road extending from William Penn Highway northwardly to the Penn-Lincoln Parkway, and along Moss Side Boulevard from William Penn Highway southwardly to Haymaker Road.

Section 2. That the said Consultant shall act as an independent contractor for the Borough and under the terms and conditions of his Proposal to the Borough dated November 6, 1968, provided that in no event shall the total obligations of the Borough for this work exceed the sum of Eight Thousand (\$8,000.00) Dollars without prior approval of Monroeville Borough Council.

Section 3. That the costs and expenses incurred in pursuance of this Ordinance shall be paid out of the Bond Issue Fund Series 1968.

Section 4. That any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
