

ORDINANCE NO. 626

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE CONSENTING TO THE WIDENING AND RECONSTRUCTION OF TURTLE CREEK & MONROEVILLE ROAD, MONROEVILLE-PITCAIRN CONNECTING ROAD AND A PORTION OF MONROEVILLE-TRESTLE ROAD, TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Consent is hereby given by the Borough of Monroeville to the County of Allegheny to widen and reconstruct Turtle Creek & Monroeville Road (sometimes known as Monroeville Road), Monroeville-Pitcairn Connecting Road (sometimes known as Northern Pike), and a portion of Monroeville-Trestle Road (sometimes known as Center Road), substantially according to the Allegheny County Condemnation Plan No. 2252 to be filed with the Court of Quarter Sessions of Allegheny County.

Section 2. Any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
