

ORDINANCE NO. 628

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REGULATING THE SPEED OF VEHICLES AND DESCRIBING "NO PASSING ZONE" ON BEATTY ROAD IN ITS ENTIRE LENGTH FROM OLD WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY TO CENTER ROAD, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That from and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be operated over and upon Beatty Road in the Borough of Monroeville at a speed in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

Section 2. That for the promotion and preservation of peace and safety in the Borough of Monroeville there is hereby created a "No Passing Zone" upon and along the entire length of Beatty Road from its intersection with Old William Penn Highway to its intersection with Center Road in said Borough.

Section 3. That from and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any vehicle using or traveling upon Beatty Road to pass another vehicle being operated in the same direction as the passing vehicle.

Section 4. There shall be erected by the proper officers of the Borough appropriate signs designating the beginning and the end of the said "No Passing Zone" upon Beatty Road, and these signs shall be placed at a distance less than one-eighth of a mile between signs.

Section 5. There shall be erected by the proper officers of the Borough appropriate signs along Beatty Road indicating that the speed limit on said road shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

Section 6. Any person or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in summary proceedings before the Mayor or any Justice of the Peace, be subject to pay a fine of ten (\$10.00) dollars, together with costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of said fine and costs shall be committed to the Allegheny County Jail for a period of not more than five (5) days.

Section 7. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
