

ORDINANCE NO. 639

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE VACATING A PORTION OF RAMSEY ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The following described portion of Ramsey Road, to its full right-of-way width (33 feet), shall be and the same is hereby vacated:

Commencing at a point at the Southwest corner of property now or formerly of Henry F. Sulecky; thence along the center line of Ramsey Road as it now exists in a Southwesterly direction, a distance of one thousand eight hundred fifty (1,850) feet, more or less, to a point in Ramsey Road at the Northwest corner of property of Vincent Rokicsak.

Section 2. In vacating said portion of Ramsey Road the Borough of Monroeville hereby quitclaims to such persons, firms or corporations as may lawfully acquire title thereto under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, such interest as the Borough may have had in the same prior to the vacating thereof.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective April 10, 1969 unless repealed prior thereto or other formal action taken by the Borough of Monroeville to stay such effective date.

Section 4. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
