

ORDINANCE NO. 658

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE ESTABLISHING
NAMES FOR VARIOUS PARKS AND RECREATION PLACES IN THE
BOROUGH

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately two and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) acres, located on the easterly side of Fieldstone Drive, shall be hereafter named and designated as GARDEN PARK.

Section 2. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately ten (10) acres, located on the westerly side of Fairlawn Drive, shall be hereafter named and designated as EVERGREEN PARK.

Section 3. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately thirty-six (36) acres, located on the westerly side of Rosecrest Drive south of Poplar Avenue, shall be hereafter named and designated as PIONEER PARK.

Section 4. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately seventy-three (73) acres, located east of Northwestern Drive and of Harvest Drive and lying generally between Haymaker Road and Saunders Station Road, shall be hereafter named and designated as BEECHWOOD PARK.

Section 5. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately ninety-two (92) acres, located along the westerly side of Cavitt Road and within and adjacent to the Alpine Village Plans of Lots, shall be hereafter named and designated as ALPINE PARK.

Section 6. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately thirteen (13) acres, located northeast of Hawkeye Drive, shall be hereafter named and designated as HAWKEYE PARK.

Section 7. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately twelve (12) acres, located northwest of Bellwood Avenue, shall be hereafter named and designated as BELLWOOD PARK.

Section 8. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately seven and $\frac{9}{10}$ (7.9) acres, located adjacent to Mellon Plan School, shall be hereafter named and designated as OVERLOOK PARK.

Section 9. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately seventy-three (73) acres, located along the north-easterly side of Saunders Station Road and the southerly side of McGinley Road, shall be hereafter named and designated as HERITAGE PARK.

Section 10. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately thirteen (13) acres, located adjacent to the Northern Pike Grade School and the Turnpike Gardens Plans of Lots, shall be hereafter named and designated as FERNDALE PARK.

Section 11. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately sixty-six (66) acres, lying along the easterly side of Tilbrook Road, shall be hereafter named and designated as MONROEVILLE PARK.

Section 12. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately fourteen (14) acres, located along the southeasterly side of Abers Creek Road and the southerly side of Cavitt Road, shall be hereafter named and designated as VALLEY PARK.

Section 13. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately fifty (50) acres, located north of Kelvington Drive, shall be hereafter named and designated as KELVINGTON PARK.

Section 14. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately one (1) acre, located south of Griffin Road, shall be hereafter named and designated as MADDEN PARK.

Section 15. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) acre, located along the southeasterly side of Bellwood Avenue, shall be hereafter named and designated as BELLWOOD NEIGHBORHOOD RECREATION CENTER.

Section 16. That park and open space land of the Borough of Monroeville consisting of approximately thirty-nine (39) acres, located north of Garden City Drive, shall be hereafter named and designated as GLENWOOD PARK.

Section 17. The precise location of the above designated park, open space and recreation sites shall be as shown on the official map for the same, dated this date, and on file in the office of the Monroeville Borough Manager, Municipal Building, Monroeville, Pennsylvania.

Section 18. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
