

ORDINANCE NO. 675

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER LINE KNOWN AS JAMES STREET SANITARY SEWER PROJECT CONTRACT NO. 6904-S, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF SUCH CONTRACT.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That a sanitary sewer line be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville to provide sanitary sewer service for an area of the Borough of Monroeville in the vicinity of James Street, in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as James Street Sanitary Sewer Contract No. 6904-S.

Section 2. Upon the opening of bids for the building of said sewer project it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was William H. O'Brien & Son, Inc., whose total bid, based on quantities contained in said contract, was Sixty-three Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-two and 50/100 (\$63,862.50) Dollars.

Section 3. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with William H. O'Brien & Son, Inc. for the construction of the said Contract No. 6904-S for the said sum of Sixty-three Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-two and 50/100 (\$63,862.50) Dollars. Upon the execution of the said contract said contractor shall file with the Monroeville Borough Manager a performance bond, labor and materialmen's bond, maintenance bond and certificates of insurance, as required in said contract.
