

ORDINANCE NO. 690

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE ADOPTING THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE AS THE ELECTRICAL CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AND DESIGNATING THE MIDDLE ASSOCIATION FIRE UNDERWRITERS AS THE OFFICIAL IN CHARGE OF INSPECTING AND ENFORCING THE ELECTRICAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. That a certain document, one or more copies of which are on file in the office of the Borough Secretary of the Borough of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, being marked and designated as "National Electrical Code 1968" and subsequent amendments thereto as published by the National Fire Protection Association, be and the same is hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the Borough of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, for the control of the use of electricity within or on public and private buildings and other premises as provided therein; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of the National Electrical Code 1968 and subsequent amendments thereto are hereby referred to, adopted and made part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance.

Section 2. That the District Inspector of the Middle Department Association of Fire Underwriters is hereby designated as the official charged with the inspections and enforcement of the National Electrical Code for the Borough of Monroeville. A copy of all reports and findings made by the District Inspector shall be kept on file in the office of the Borough Manager of the Borough of Monroeville.

Section 3. That the District Inspector of the Middle Department Association of Fire Underwriters, or his duly authorized agent, shall have authority to enter any building, structure or premises in the Borough of Monroeville at any reasonable time for the purpose of making any inspection as provided in the National Electrical Code.

Section 4. That no construction, installation or repair of any electrical wiring, electrical machinery or other electrical apparatus shall be done until the manner and method of installation, construction or repair has been inspected and approved by the District Inspector, and a permit issued. The fee schedule for permits shall be on file with the Borough Secretary. Any changes in the fee schedule are subject to the approval of Borough Council.

Section 5. That as used in the National Electrical Code, the word "municipality" shall mean the Borough of Monroeville, and the word "corporate counsel" shall mean the Solicitor of the Borough of Monroeville.

Section 6. That any person violating any of the provisions contained in the National Electrical Code shall, upon conviction before a Justice of the Peace of the Borough of Monroeville, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars. Each and every day that a violation occurs or remains, shall constitute a separate offense, punishable by a like fine.

Section 7. Should any section, paragraph, sentence or word of this Ordinance or of the Code herein adopted, be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, it is the intent of the Borough of Monroeville that it would have enacted all other portions of this Ordinance of the Code adopted hereby, independent of the section declared invalid.
