

ORDINANCE NO. 696

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 628, REGULATING THE SPEED OF VEHICLES AND DESCRIBING "NO PASSING ZONE" ON BEATTY ROAD IN ITS ENTIRE LENGTH FROM OLD WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY TO CENTER ROAD, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 628 of the Borough of Monroeville is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That from and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be operated over and upon Beatty Road in the Borough of Monroeville at a speed in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

Section 2. Section 5 of said Ordinance No. 628 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. There shall be erected by the proper officers of the Borough appropriate signs along Beatty Road indicating that the speed limit on said road shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

Section 3. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
