

ORDINANCE NO. 699

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF HAYMAKER ROAD AND MCGINLEY ROAD AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF CONTRACT NO. 70-TS-3-B FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SUCH SIGNALS

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That traffic signals be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville at the intersection of Haymaker Road and McGinley Road in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Contract No. 70-TS-3-B.

Section 2. In the opening of bids for the construction of the said traffic signals, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Traffic Control and Engineering Company, whose total bid based on quantities contained in the said contract for the Corten Steel poles and Corten Steel mast arms and other necessary equipment was Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred (\$13,800.00) Dollars with completion by October 15, 1970, and an additional Six Hundred Fifty (\$650.00) Dollars for failure of completion by that date. If the signals are not operational between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. by October 15, 1970, an additional penalty of Seventy-Five (\$75.00) Dollars per calendar day thereafter shall be paid by the contractor to the Borough.

Section 3. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Traffic Control and Engineering Company for the construction under said Contract No. 70-TS-3-B, as above set forth. Upon the execution of the said contract, said contractor shall file with the Borough Engineer a performance bond, labor and materials bond, maintenance bond and certificates of insurance as required by the said contract.
