

ORDINANCE NO. 700

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF NORTHERN PIKE AND CIRCLE W DRIVE AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF CONTRACT NO. 70-TS-2-B FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SUCH SIGNALS

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That traffic signals be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville at the intersection of Northern Pike and Circle W Drive in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Contract No. 70-TS-2-B.

Section 2. In the opening of bids for the construction of the said traffic signals, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Traffic Control and Engineering Company, whose total bid based on alternate No. 1 in said contract was Sixteen Thousand (\$16,000.00) Dollars with completion by October 15, 1970, and a penalty of \$75.00 per calendar day thereafter that the signals do not operate between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Section 3. The proper officers of the Borough are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Traffic Control and Engineering Company for the construction under said Contract No. 70-TS-2-B for the sum of Sixteen Thousand (\$16,000.00) Dollars. Upon the execution of the said contract, said Contractor shall file with the Borough Engineer a performance bond, labor and materials bond, maintenance bond and certificates of insurance as required by the said contract.
