

ORDINANCE NO. 771

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 368 PROVIDING FOR THE COMPLETE ENCLOSURE OF ALL LOADS OF RUBBISH OR REFUSE BEING TRANSPORTED WITHIN OR THROUGH THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1 Ordinance No. 368 is hereby amended, by adding thereto Section 7-A as follows:

- Section 7-A (1) Any truck or other vehicle in the act of transporting rubbish or refuse, as defined herein, excluding abandoned automobiles, or major household appliances, within or through the Borough of Monroeville, shall be completely enclosed, either through the design of the truck, or the vehicle, or if not designed with top cover and end cover, by utilizing canvas or other durable weather-resistant material securely attached to the truck, or other vehicle, which completely covers the top, open sides or any other opening in the truck, or other vehicle, through which rubbish or refuse may be discharged.
- (2) Any person, firm, corporation, partnership or political subdivision, acting in violation of paragraph (1) above, shall, upon summary conviction thereof, be fined in the amount of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), or in lieu of payment of fine be imprisoned in Allegheny County jail not exceeding five (5) days. Each load of refuse or rubbish hauled in a truck violating the above provisions shall be considered a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

Section 2 Any Ordinance, or part of Ordinance, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, is repealed, to the extent of such conflict.
