

ORDINANCE NO. 777

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE CANCELLING
UNUSED ELECTORAL AUTHORIZATION TO INCUR DEBT

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council
assembled, as follows:

WHEREAS, at an election held on the 21st day of May, 1963 the electors of
the Borough of Monroeville authorized the increase of the indebtedness of
said Borough in the amount of \$20,000.00;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said authorization, the Borough of Monroeville
incurred no debt leaving unused \$20,000.00, principal amount, of such authoriza-
tion (hereinafter called the "Unused Authorization");

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Monroeville has determined that it
would be impractical to issue debt pursuant to said Unused Authorization and
it desires to cancel such Unused Authorization;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority of the
same as follows:

Section 1. The Unused Authorization to incur debt granted by vote of the
electorate as above described is hereby cancelled and no debt shall ever be
incurred pursuant thereto.

Section 2. The Secretary of the Borough acting on behalf of Council is
hereby authorized and directed to file a Certificate of Cancellation with the
Department of Community Affairs of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and is
further authorized and directed to do all further acts and things required to
be done by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and this Ordinance in
order to properly carry out and fulfill the purposes thereof and hereof.
