

ORDINANCE NO. 780

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE
VACATING A PORTION OF LOLLY DRIVE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. That a portion of the right-of-way of Lolly Drive abutting the parcel of property of the Borough of Monroeville which is to become a part of Ferndale Park shall be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part of Ferndale Park:

All that certain lot or parcel of ground.

Beginning at a point on the westerly side of Lolly Drive (a 50 ft. street) being the northeasterly corner of Lot No. 161 of the Turnpike Gardens addition No. 1 as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania in P.V.B. 59, Pages 119 through 121; thence through Lolly Drive N 65° 19' 40" E, 11.00 ft. to a point; thence continuing through same N 24° 40' 20" W, 333.58 ft. to a point; thence continuing through same S 65° 19' 40", 11.00 ft. to a point at the southeasterly corner of Lot No. 25 in the Turnpike Gardens Plan as recorded in P.V.B. 55, pages 104 through 108; thence along the westerly side of said Lolly Drive S 24° 40' 20" E, 333.58 ft. to the place of beginning.

A Plan of Survey of the portion vacated is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective on the 14th day of April 1972, unless repealed prior thereto or other formal action is taken by the Borough of Monroeville to stay such effective date, with proper notice to be given abutting property owners in accordance with the Borough Code.

Section 3. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
