

ORDINANCE NO. 781

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 602 IMPOSING AN OCCUPATION PRIVILEGE TAX

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 602, known as the "Occupational Privilege Tax Ordinance," enacted May 14, 1968 is hereby amended by the addition of the following sentence:

The tax hereby levied shall not be imposed upon any natural person having attained the age of sixty-five (65) years prior to January 1, 1972 or prior to January 1 of each following calendar year whose total earned income during the taxable year is not in excess of One Thousand six hundred and Eighty (\$1,680.00) Dollars.

Section 2. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with any provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, unlawful or invalid, such decision shall not affect the constitutionality, legality or validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Council of the Borough of Monroeville declares that it would have passed this ordinance and any remaining section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, sub-sections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, unlawful or invalid.
