

ORDINANCE NO. 791

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE QUESTION OF THE ELECTION OF A GOVERNMENT STUDY COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows :

Section 1. That an election be authorized to be held in the Borough of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, to determine whether a Government Study Commission of Eleven (11) members shall be elected to study the charter and plan of government of the Borough, to study and consider the advisability of adoption of the Optional Plan of Government or a Home Rule Charter and to recommend whether or not an Optional Form of Government or a Home Rule Charter should be adopted.

Section 2. That the Borough Secretary shall within five (5) days of the final enactment of this Ordinance file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Allegheny County Board of Elections, together with a copy of the question to be submitted to the electors, which shall be as follows: "Shall a Government Study Commission of Eleven (11) members be elected to study the charter and plan of government of the Borough of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, to study and consider the advisability of the adoption of an Optional Plan of Government or a Home Rule Charter and to recommend whether or not an Optional Form of Government or a Home Rule Charter should be adopted?"

Section 3. This Ordinance is adopted under authority of the Act of the General Assembly No. 62 of April 13, 1972 known as the "Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law".
