

ORDINANCE NO. 796

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FIRE LANES AND ENFORCEMENT

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 713 of the Borough of Monroeville shall be amended by the adding of the following:

No person, firm or corporation may place or cause to be placed any sign adjacent to such fire lane indicating a "loading zone", "pick-up" area, "parking" area or similar sign indicating parking or stopping is permitted in the fire lanes.

Section 2. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 713 of the Borough of Monroeville shall be amended by the adding of the following:

Any person, firm or corporation who places or causes to be placed any sign adjacent to such fire lane indicating a loading zone will be prosecuted by the fire official. A fine of \$50.00 shall be imposed for each violation; and each day that such a sign shall remain shall constitute a separate violation.
