

ORDINANCE NO. 801

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF WOODHAVEN DRIVE STORM SEWER, CONTRACT NO. 72-SS-2, THE REPAVING OF CERTAIN BOROUGH STREETS, AND THE PURCHASE OF REINFORCED CONCRETE PIPE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACTS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. That a storm sewer be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville in the area of the Borough of Woodhaven Drive in accordance with plans and specifications therefore known as Woodhaven Drive Storm Sewer Contract No. 72-SS-2.

Section 2. That certain Borough streets be repaved in accordance with plans and specifications advertised for bidding on July 11, 1972. Further, that concrete pipe be purchased in accordance with the specifications advertised for bidding on July 11, 1972.

Section 3. Upon the opening of bids for the building of Woodhaven Drive Storm Sewer Contract No. 72-SS-2, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Frank Mannella & Sons, Inc., whose total bid, based on quantities contained in said contract, was Twenty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixteen Dollars (\$23,816.00).

Section 4. Upon the opening of bids for the repaving of various Borough Streets under Section 2 of the 1971 paving program, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Burrell Construction & Supply Company, whose total bid, based on quantities contained in said contract, was Thirty-Eight Thousand One Hundred and Fifty-Six Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$38,156.50). Upon the opening of bids for the purchase of concrete pipe, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was U. S. Concrete Pipe Company, whose total bid, based on quantities contained in the specifications, was Fifty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred and Thirty-Six Dollars (\$59,436.00).

Section 5. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Frank Mannella & Sons, Inc., for the construction of said Contract No. 72-SS-2 for the said sum of Twenty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixteen Dollars (\$23,816.00); and to enter into a contract with Burrell Construction & Supply Company for the repaving of various Borough streets for the said sum of Thirty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$38,156.50); and to enter into a contract with U. S. Concrete Pipe Company for the purchase of concrete pipe for the said sum of Fifty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred and Thirty-Six Dollars (\$59,436.00). Upon the execution of the said contracts, said contractors shall file with the Monroeville Borough Manager such performance bonds, labor and materialmen's bonds, maintenance bonds, and certificates of insurance, as required in the said contracts.
