

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE RECONSTRUCTION OF TILBROOK ROAD EXTENSION, CONTRACT NO. 72-R-1, AND THE REPAVING OF CERTAIN BOROUGH STREETS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACTS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That Tilbrook Road Extension be reconstructed from Station 46+00 to Station 67+00 in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Tilbrook Road Extension Contract No. 72-R-1.

Section 2. That certain Borough streets be repaved in accordance with plans and specifications advertised for bidding on August 8, 1972, under Section 3 of the paving program.

Section 3. Upon the opening of bids for the reconstruction of Tilbrook Road Extension Contract No. 72-R-1, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Russell Standard Corporation, whose total bid, based on quantities contained in said Contract, was Sixty-Eight Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$68,122.70).

Section 4. Upon the opening of bids for the repaving of various Borough streets under Section 3 of the paving program, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Burrell Construction and Supply Company, whose total bid, based on quantities contained in said contract, was Forty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$42,790.00).

Section 5. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Russell Standard Corporation for the construction of said Contract No. 72-R-1 for the said sum of Sixty-Eight Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars and Seventy Cents, (\$68,122.70), and to enter into a Contract with Burrell Construction and Supply Company for the repaving of various Borough Streets for the said sum of Forty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$42,790.00). Upon the execution of the said contracts, the contractors shall file with the Monroeville Borough Manager such performance bonds, labor and materialmen's bonds, maintenance bonds, and certificates of insurance, as required in the said contracts.
