

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF MOSSIDE BOULEVARD AND NORTHERN PIKE, AT THE INTERSECTION OF MOSSIDE BOULEVARD, HAYMAKER ROAD AND GATEWAY HIGH SCHOOL DRIVE AND AT THE INTERSECTION OF MONROEVILLE BOULEVARD AND JAMISON LANE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That traffic signals be installed at the intersection of Mosside Boulevard and Northern Pike in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Contract No. 72-TS-1; and that traffic signals be installed at the intersection of Mosside Boulevard, Haymaker Road and Gateway High School Drive in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Contract No. 72-TS-2; and that traffic signals be installed at the intersection of Monroeville Boulevard and Jamison Lane in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Contract No. 72-TS-3.

Section 2. Upon the opening of bids for the traffic signals at the intersection of Mosside Boulevard and Northern Pike, Contract No. 72-TS-1, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Lightning Electric Company, whose total bid based on quantities contained in said contract was Twenty Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty-Six (\$20,926.00) Dollars.

Upon opening of bids for the traffic signals at the intersection of Mosside Boulevard, Haymaker Road and Gateway High School Drive, Contract No. 72-TS-2, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Lightning Electric Company, whose total bid based on quantities contained in said contract was Twenty-Three Thousand, Four Hundred, Fourteen (\$23,414.00) Dollars.

Upon the opening of bids for the traffic signals at the intersection of Monroeville Boulevard and Jamison Lane, Contract No. 72-TS-3, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Lightning Electric Company whose total bid based on quantities contained in said contract was Twenty Thousand, Six Hundred Ninety-Three (\$20,693.00) Dollars.

Section 3. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Lightning Electric Company for the installation pursuant to said Contract No. 72-TS-1 for the said sum of Twenty Thousand, Nine Hundred, Twenty-Six (\$20,926.00) Dollars; and to enter into a contract with Lightning Electric Company for the installation pursuant to said Contract No. 72-TS-2 for the said sum of Twenty-Three Thousand, Four Hundred, Fourteen (\$23,414.00) Dollars; and to enter into a contract with Lightning Electric Company for the installation pursuant to said Contract No. 72-TS-3 for the said sum of Twenty Thousand, Six Hundred, Ninety-Three (\$20,693.00) Dollars, subject to confirmation by Allegheny County as to the reimbursement by Allegheny County for the cost thereof. Upon the execution of the said Contracts, the said contractor

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shall file with the Monroeville Borough Manager such performance bonds, labor and materialmen's bonds, maintenance bonds, and certificates of insurance as required in said contracts.
