

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE IMPROVEMENT OF FERNDALE AND HAWKEYE PARK SITES, CONTRACT NO. 500M, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That Ferndale Park Site and Hawkeye Park Site be improved in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Contract No. 500M Project No. 3-4-73-63-2 and Project No. 3-4-73-63-8, respectively, and that the proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts with the low bidders set forth below, and upon the execution of the said contracts to require the contractors to file with the Monroeville Borough Manager such performance bonds, labor and materialmen's bonds, maintenance bonds and certificates of insurance as required in the said contracts.

Section 2. The following were the low bids received for Ferndale Park Site Improvement, Contract No. 500M Project No. 3-4-73-63-2 on November 14, 1972 and December 12, 1972: General Construction, Joseph Vaccarello/Penn Landscape & Cement Work \$94,412.00; Electric, Paul E. Smith, Jr. \$1,609.00; Plumbing, Zangrille Plumbing Company, \$4,545.00; Heating and Ventilating, Elk Air Conditioning, Inc., \$2,550.00.

Section 3. The low bids received for Hawkeye Park Site Improvement, Contract No. 500M, Project No. 3-4-73-63-8 received on November 14, 1972 and December 12, 1972 were as follows: General Construction, Joseph Vaccarello/Penn Landscape & Cement Work \$138,300.00; Electric, Wilco Electric, Inc., \$2,200.00; Plumbing, Zangrille Plumbing Company, \$4,646.00; Heating and Ventilating, Elk Air Conditioning, Inc., \$2,550.00.
